



LIVING LIKE CAVEMEN: A Stone Age Adventure

Key Stage 1&2

Aim: To give students a hands on experience of the Stone Age, where they learn about the lives of early humans and explore historical and scientific ideas, by being in the woods and experimenting with it first hand, building their own shelter and making tools to make fire.
